Rating Support for Providers During the Pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic has hit child care providers particularly hard. To support providers in focusing on day-to-day operations, keeping children in care safely, and supporting families and the community, the Michigan Department of Education-Office of Great Start is providing three phases of support for providers participating in Great Start to Quality. This includes rating extensions, rating restorations, and supplemental subsidy payments.
