## **MiRegistry Staff Position Titles**

The following are the position title options for staff to select in MiRegistry while completing their employment information. Knowing programs may use different names for various staff titles, there are common examples of staff titles. If the program uses any of the example staff titles listed, use the corresponding position title option in MiRegistry.

Administrator/Program Director/Schoolage Site Supervisor	The individual who oversees the daily operation of the program and is onsite for the majority of the day serving children of all ages.	<ul> <li>Administrator/Administrative Director</li> <li>Early Childhood Program Director</li> <li>Interim Director</li> <li>Program Director</li> <li>Schoolage Program Director</li> <li>Site Supervisor</li> </ul>
Assistant Director	The individual who supports the Administrator/Program Director/Schoolage Site Supervisor in the daily operation of the program and is onsite for the majority of the day serving children of all ages.	<ul> <li>Assistant Program Director</li> <li>Assistant Site Supervisor</li> <li>Early Childhood Assistant Program Director</li> <li>Interim Assistant Director</li> <li>Schoolage Assistant Program Director</li> </ul>
Owner/Operator	The individual who owns and/or runs the business.	<ul> <li>Family Child Care Owner/Administrator</li> <li>Program Owner</li> </ul>

Lead Caregiver/Teacher	The individual who is regularly scheduled <b>and</b> is included in licensing adult-to-child ratios. This individual works with children ages birth through kindergarten entry.	<ul> <li>Co-Lead Teacher</li> <li>Directress/Guide</li> <li>Family Child Care Lead Teacher</li> <li>Head Teacher</li> <li>Interim Lead</li> <li>Lead Teacher</li> </ul>
Schoolage Teacher	The individual who is regularly scheduled and is included in licensing adult-to-child ratios. This individual works with schoolagers ages kindergarten entry through age 12.	<ul> <li>Interim Staff</li> <li>Schoolage Assistant Staff</li> <li>Schoolage Head Teacher</li> <li>Schoolage Lead Teacher</li> <li>Schoolage Staff</li> </ul>
Assistant Teacher/Family Child Care Assistant	<ul> <li>The individual who is regularly scheduled and is included in licensing adult-to-child ratios working with children ages</li> <li>Family Group Homes- Birth through age 12.</li> <li>Centers- Birth through kindergarten entry.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>3<sup>rd</sup> Person</li> <li>Assistant Caregivers</li> <li>Assistant Teachers</li> <li>Classroom Aide</li> <li>Family Child Care Assistants</li> <li>Interim Assistant Staff</li> </ul>

Non-Teaching Professional Staff	The individual who provides specific support to the program, staff, or children. This individual is <b>not</b> included in licensing adult-to-child ratios.	<ul> <li>Atelierista</li> <li>Behavioral Support Staff</li> <li>Coaches</li> <li>Curriculum Coordinator</li> <li>Early Childhood Specialist</li> <li>Family Advocate</li> <li>Home Visitor</li> <li>Occupational Therapist</li> <li>Office Staff</li> <li>Parent Coordinator</li> <li>Speech Therapist</li> </ul>
Non-Teaching Support Staff	The individual who supports the daily operations of the program. This individual is <b>not</b> included in licensing adult-to-child ratios.	<ul> <li>Bus Driver</li> <li>Cook</li> <li>Custodian</li> <li>Maintenance</li> <li>Office Staff</li> </ul>
Support Staff	The individual who provides additional classroom support and works with children in the classroom. This individual is <b>not</b> included in licensing adult-to-child ratios.	<ul> <li>Float</li> <li>Individual Child Aide</li> <li>Paraprofessional</li> </ul>
Substitute	The individual who fills in for another staff member who is absent from work. This individual <b>is</b> included in licensing adult-to-child ratios. This individual works with children ages birth through 12.	<ul> <li>Ancillary Teacher</li> <li>Family Child Care Emergency Caregiver On-call Teacher</li> <li>Subs</li> </ul>

MiRegistry Position Title	Definition	Examples of commonly used staff position names
Intern	The individual who provides direct child care functions and related duties.	<ul><li>College Intern</li><li>Student Teacher</li></ul>
	This individual works under the supervision of program staff.	
	This individual is <b>not</b> included in licensing adult-to-child ratios.	
	This individual works with children ages birth through 12.	
Volunteer	The individual who provides service for a child care center that is not compensated This individual is supervised at all times when children are in care.	<ul> <li>Community Member</li> <li>Co-Op Individual</li> <li>Family Member</li> <li>Grandparent</li> </ul>
Other	Any individual that supports a program in a way not defined by another MiRegistry position title.	Family Child Care Emergency     Caregiver

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
