How GSQ Evaluates Quality

High-quality care programs help children find a safe place to learn, explore their world and build relationships. GSQ supports quality through training, coaching and evaluation and uses these five indicators for quality evaluation.

- Family and Community Partnerships:
 Program works with other community partners and shares development information with families.
- Curriculum, Instruction, and Learning Environment:
 Program tracks child development and age appropriate learning.
- Staff Qualifications:
 Program has documented staff qualifications, certifications, training, personnel policies, and procedures.
- Inclusive Practices:
 Program supports family cultures, recognizes student diversity use of home language, and ensures that all children have an equal opportunity to succeed.
- Professional Development:
 Program continuously works on developing skills and knowledge around early childhood and child development.
