Approved Assessor Timeline 2024-2025 School Year

Programs who have Observations (CLASS and ERS) completed in the program, must have the person who completed the Observation become an Approved Assessor and agree to enter in scores within 30 days of assignment. ECIC will not conduct observations in programs that have already received an observation.

The Approved Assessor must enter in all the required cycle scores (based on the tool), upload proper documentation*, and submit for approval in MiRegistry by June 30th.

*Proper documentation is proof that an observation took place and must include all cycle scores. Preferred documentation is handwritten or typed scoresheets with observer notes. Teachstone's overview report is not enough documentation unless it is the report with all cycle scores. Scoring documentation is for internal use only and is not shared with programs.

Programs must submit their updated Self-Reflection and have their Coach Review by March 20th to have the Approved Assessor enter in 2024-2025 scores. Program submitting the Self-Reflection after March 20, must enter 2025-2026 scores within 30 days of assignment.

If the Approved Assessor does not enter scores by June 30th the program's case will be completed. Because all age groups within a program must meet threshold scores, the program will publish at Enhancing Quality-Validated since the Approved Assessor scores would be zeros, and any On-Site Observation window scheduled with a GSQ Assessor (for additional observations) will be cancelled.

Below is the timeline and process for programs who had an Approved Assessor complete at least one Observation (CLASS or ERS) in 2024-2025 school year wishing to use those scores for Great Start to Quality.
